Please ensure that your child arrives at pre-school at their allocated time and are collected at the time agreed.



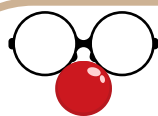

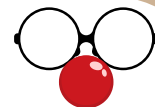
Pre-school will be closed for Bank holiday Monday – 6th May 2024
