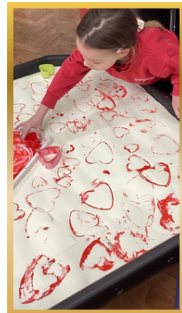
## FEBRUARY 2025

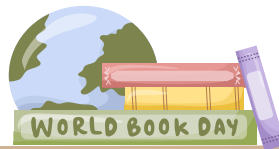
